

Frequently asked accommodation questions prior to your arrival at Cambridge

Q: I've submitted my online request to be considered for accommodation before the deadline, but it's now past the deadline and I haven't heard back; will I get accommodation?

A: If you have met all of the conditions set by the University's Graduate Admissions Office by the College's deadline then you will be offered accommodation. The Accommodation Office will contact you as soon as possible but please bear in mind that this time of year is extremely busy and that there may be a delay in replying. This does not mean you have been forgotten or that your enquiry is not important to us.

Q: I've submitted my online request to be considered for accommodation past the deadline, will I get accommodation?

A: The College endeavours to offer all Fresher graduate students accommodation but if you have missed the deadline then it cannot be guaranteed

Q: It's late August. I've submitted my online request to be considered for accommodation before the deadline, and I got a reply, but I haven't heard anything since, should I be looking for private accommodation?

A: If you have met all of the conditions set by the University Graduate Admissions Office, by the deadline then you will be offered accommodation

Q: Why does the College say that they need to wait for the University's Graduate Admissions Office to confirm my place, I thought I was already confirmed?

A: Your place at Caius is not guaranteed until you have met all of the conditions set by the University's Graduate Admissions Office. Confirmation of College membership is a separate process. Accommodation can only be allocated once you have been confirmed by the University (ie met all of your conditions for example funding, degree results etc). This confirmation needs to be showing on your CamSIS record
