The History of Art Admissions Assessment will be taken via the assessment Moodle platform. You may take the assessment at your home or school – whichever environment feels the most comfortable to you and has the most reliable internet connection. The assessment will not be invigilated.

You have <u>60 minutes</u> to complete the assessment, an additional 30 minutes is provided to allow you to download the assessment paper and upload your completed response. If you have been granted extra time to complete the assessment, then please refer to the timing provided to you by the College assessing your application.

In this paper you will find five pairs of images. Key information about the artists, titles, dates, media, size and locations has also been provided, as appropriate.

Choose any **TWO** pairs and compare and contrast them in ways that seem most meaningful to you. It is recommended that you spend about 30 minutes on each pair.

Your responses should be written in English and typed, for electronic submission within the time window. If you have been given permission by the college which is considering your application to handwrite your responses, you will need to make a PDF of them for electronic submission within the same time window.

Responses must be returned before the window closes. It is essential that you include your name and UCAS Personal ID number at the top of any document uploaded and that you save your answer with the file name UCAS number_College_Surname_First Name.

Answers will be checked for academic integrity, including plagiarism and the undeclared use of artificial intelligence; this will include where passages have been produced by AI and manually rewritten. Breaches of academic integrity are taken seriously and will invalidate your application
