The Linguistics written assessment will be invigilated via Zoom. We will send you a link to access the session and detailed instructions shortly before the test date. You may take the assessment at your home or school – whichever environment feels the most comfortable to you and has the most reliable internet connection.

This assessment consists of three parts, which should each take about 20 minutes.

You will have **60 Minutes** to complete this test. If you have been granted extra time to complete the assessment due to special circumstances, then please refer to the timing provided to you by the College assessing your application.

You are **NOT** allowed to communicate with anyone or use any resources (dictionaries, books, the internet, etc) during the test: you do not need anything apart from the information provided in the paper to formulate your answers. Failure to abide by this rubric will invalidate your application.

All parts contain data questions about different aspects of Linguistics. Each part is worth 30 marks, giving a 90-mark maximum for the overall written test.
