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- P.B. Shelley, *Complete Poetical Works*, ed. Neville Rogers (2 vols, Oxford, 1972-5) [to have been 4 vols; 2 vols only published, covering work from 1802-1817; series abandoned].
- P.B. Shelley, *Selected Poetry*, ed. Neville Rogers (Oxford, 1968). [Includes most of the major poems, with minimal notes; there have been objections to these text-versions].
- P.B. Shelley, *The Poems of Shelley*, ed. Geoffrey Matthews and Kelvin Everest, Vol. 1: 1804-1817, Vol. 2: 1817-1819 (Longman Annotated English Poets, Harlow, 1989-) [2 vols so far, with full notes and commentary].
- P.B. Shelley, *The Complete Poetry*, ed. Donald Reiman and Neil Fraistat (Baltimore, Md, c.2000-) [2 vols so far, excellent intro. and full notes; Vol. 2 (2004) includes full text of *Queen Mab*; *A Philosophical Poem: With Notes*, plus detailed commentary].
- P.B. Shelley, *The Major Works*, ed. Zachary Leader and Michael O'Neill (World's Classics, paperback; Oxford, 2003) [including poetry, prose, and drama; best interim text, with the Norton selection, below].
- P.B. Shelley, *Poetry and Prose*, ed. Donald Reiman and Neil Fraistat (Norton Critical Edition, New York, 2nd ed., c.2002) [best interim text, with the Oxford World's Classics selection, above].
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
